

The expression of interest submitted by the Shire to RDA Wheatbelt to develop a submission for Federal regional funding for the Avondale project was not supported in the current round.




- 1. Outside foyer of Beverley Shire Office

BROOKTON TRIATHLON JUST AROUND THE CORNER!

The hugely successful Brookton Triathlon is back again in 2012, with the exciting community event set to take place on Sunday 26 February at the Brookton Aquatic Centre.

The event saw almost 90 competitors from all over the Wheatbelt and further afield, compete in the 2011 'I swam in a drought' Triathlon, and we hope to see even more participants in 2012.

This year's Triathlon sees the introduction of a Corporate Cup, to encourage clubs and local businesses to get out, get active and have fun! The team chosen from each club or business will be competing against other clubs/ businesses in the novice event, to become the first winners of the inaugural Brookton Triathlon 2012 Corporate Cup.

The popular Fun Course category will be back again in 2012, open to anyone and everyone of all ages, including mums, dads, brothers, sisters, grandparents, friends and work mates. The Fun Course requires competitors to complete a 130m swim, 4km cycle and 1.5km run. This event is for teams only. For the more competitive there will be the challenging, but rewarding Open category for individuals or teams 18 years and over. This course will consist of a 400m swim, 12km cycle and 5km run - perfect for those who want a challenge, or a bit of pre-season training perhaps.

We still have the Novice category in 2012. This is perfect for those who would love to complete the Triathlon on their own, but may not be able to complete the distances set out in the Open category. The Novice course includes a 200m swim, 6km cycle and 3km run, and is open to adults and young people over 12 years competing in teams or individually.

The younger generation don't miss out either with the Junior course for individuals or teams 12 years and under completing a 100m swim, 3km cycle and 800m run.

New in 2012; the Kidlet Course, for individuals or teams of 8 years of age or under. Competitors will need

to swim one lap of the pool 33m, cycle 2km and run 500m. Great for those new to triathlons, yet still wanting to have a go - a great introductory event for all juniors.

Training programs are available now, and with just over a month until the big day, there is still plenty of time to get ready!

For those who want to be involved, but do not necessarily want to compete, there are many vital volunteer roles needed to be filled including timing, registrations, giving directions and cooking the free sausage sizzle.

The first race kicks off at 8.00 am on Sunday 26 February, and the day

will conclude with a free sausage sizzle, pool inflatable as well as some great prizes for our participants.





RE: AN OVERVIEW OF WORK AT AVONDALE 2009 - 2011

The National Trust of Australia (WA) wishes to provide an overview of heritage initiatives, planning and project outcomes since it took over responsibility for Avondale in 2009.

The Trust has demonstrated its commitment to conserve and interpret Western Australia's heritage for present and future generations at Avondale by playing an instrumental role in securing more than \$300,000 in funding and contributing \$75,000 in-kind support.

Regional community partnerships are a priority for the National Trust and with a demonstrated commitment from the Shire of Beverley and the Avondale Farm Project Association, over 20 projects have been initiated, supported or guided by the Trust in the past two years. Each project has brought direct benefits to Avondale and contributed to a strong foundation for Avondale's future. Community involvement has involved a large number of dedicated volunteers from local and surrounding communities, including members of the Ballardong people from both Beverley and Quairading.

There is the potential for Avondale to become a unique and sustainable regional attraction. However, Avondale is now at a critical point. The Trust has provided all the support it can and the results of the Royalties for Regions funding applications expected in February/March 2012 could see a financial injection of up to \$8 million in Avondale's future if successful. The Trust as well as the community are both hopeful and confident support will be received from the program which has been set up exactly for this type of project.

Background:

Avondale is listed on the State Register of Heritage Places and is protected and recognised by the Heritage of Western Australia Act 1990 for its unique heritage values.

An operational farm of approximately 710 hectares located just west of Beverley, Avondale was formerly used as an Agriculture Department Research Station (1919-2009) and was one of the earliest pastoral properties in the Beverley district dating back to the 1830s.

In the 1970s the Department created "Avondale Discovery Farm" as part of the 150th anniversary of the State to promote public education and learning about farming in the wheatbelt region. In 2005, the Department determined Avondale was not "core business" and in 2009, the National Trust took responsibility for the place.

The National Trust is a registered charity which has provided specialist heritage and project management expertise since 2009 to support the heritage values and future direction of Avondale. From the outset, the Trust has had no available financial resources to dedicate to Avondale. However, it has supported the vision proposed by the Shire and the community, that Avondale was a significant place to the local community, the region and the State.

Working in partnership with the Shire of Beverley and the Avondale Farm Project Association, the National Trust can confirm the following outcomes to date.

- National Trust has continued to open Avondale for pre-arranged groups and special events. The assistance of Avondale Farm Project Association volunteers has also enabled the property to be publicly open during school holidays.
- In partnership with Max Employment (with Shire co-ordination) and Section 95 Corrective Services it has been possible to maintain the property in a condition suitable for visitors.
- Coordinated local volunteers to carry out ongoing onsite work including horse care, machinery maintenance, and museum (Shire collection) tasks.
- The Wheatbelt Development Commission has supported an application for a grant to implement recommendations from the Master Plan. \$70,000 with a focus on establishing a support group for the Flora and Fauna Management, organisation and presentation of special events program.

While many have contributed to the substantial outcomes over the past two years the National Trust wishes to acknowledge the following individuals for their support and assistance:




