




Did You Know??



This is the death mask of a young woman who drowned in the River Seine in the 1880's. As was customary in those days, her corpse was put on display in the Paris mortuary, in the hope that someone might recognise her and claim her body.

The pathologist on duty became entranced by the girl with the half-smile, and so he commissioned a plaster cast made of her face. This mask was replicated many times over. She became known as "L'Inconnue de la Seine" or "The Unknown Woman of the Seine".

In 1955, a toymaker named Asmund Laerdal created donating them to your what we now know as the CPR Doll. Asmund wanted his manneguin to have a natural appearance. Remembering a mask on the wall of his grandparents' house many vears earlier, he decided that the L'Inconnue de la Seine would become the face of Resusci Anne - the CPR doll.

> So you see, this anonymous woman who drowned in the 19th century is responsible for saving many, many lived the world over. It is said that she has the most kissed face of all time.

The booklet is in a plastic sleeve with magnets and can be placed on your refrigerator for quick access, should the need arise.


Cultivate Creativity Workshops

Beverley Health Service



Did you know that, if your GP (General Practitioner) asks you to attend the Beverley Hospital for any reason, e.g. dressings, suture removal, ECG etc, your GP must provide a <u>Referral Letter</u> to assist the Nursing staff in attending to your health care needs in a timely manner. Please note also:

Emergencies always take precedence over Dressing Clinics and other general Medical Procedures. If the Hospital has emergency, you will be asked to wait or come back the following day.



<u>If you have a severe injury or illness,</u> <u>go to the Beverley Emergency Department. Or call 000.</u> 1 Sewell Street Beverley WA 6304

An emergency department (ED) is part of a hospital that provides 24-hour emergency care to patients who need urgent medical attention.

<u>Alternatives to going to ED</u>, if you have a minor illness or injury that does not need emergency treatment, you can ask for an appointment with your local GP.

A GP can often deal with minor emergencies such as sprains and strains, bites, stings, viruses, infections, eye injuries and ongoing illness or injury.

A pharmacy can help with colds and flu, skin conditions, allergies, headaches, diarrhoea, or constipation, or sleeping problems.

Volunteering is a voluntary act of an individual or group freely giving time and labour for a community service. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our wonderful Volunteers who contribute so much of their time. Your service to the community is always greatly appreciated. And *thank you* to the wonderful people who have donated items to the Hospital and the Alex Miles Lodge.

TREE & GARDEN SOCIETY Please bring a chair and cup/mug.

Vegetables to plant in March include - beetroot, broccoli, cabbage, carrot, leek, lettuce, radish, spinach, spring onion and turnip.

Flowers to plant in March include – alyssum, lobelia, stock, pansy, snap dragon, sweet pea and viola.

March is a great time to attend to the following tasks in your garden:

- ☆ Prune geranium and pelargonium by two-thirds to encourage new bushy growth before winter
- ☆ Remove weeds before they go to seed. The best time is after rain
- Attract butterflies to your garden by planting red, orange, purple, white and blue flowers
- ☆ Prune petunias to keep them flowering well into autumn
- \star Coffee grounds can be put to good use in the garden as slug and snail repellent or in the compost bin
- ☆ Divide agapanthus plants from autumn through to early spring
- ☆ Prune off citrus branches hanging lower than 1m above the ground to reduce the spread of brown rot
- \Rightarrow Plant bee food plants such as brachyscome, angophora, eucalyptus, callistemon, melaleuca, scaevola, grevillea, hibbertis, tea-tree and westringia
- * Scorched leaves can be a sign that soil is water repellent. If the soil is dry, apply a wetting agent and water well
- ☆ Divide clumping grass-like plants, such as dianella, lomandra and kangaroo grass. Keep several shoots per clump and remove dead material
- ☆ Harvest radish regularly to stop them becoming too hot and spicy, woody or pithy
- ☆ Start planning spring bulbs

The exercises are designed for over 50s, but younger participants are welcome. Those less mobile or those recovering from accident and illness also find the exercises useful.



On Friday afternoons the Secondary students join the York Emergency Services Cadet Corps (ESCC) students at York District High School. The ESCC developed from the idea that young Western Australians should be given every opportunity to develop as individuals and become valued members of the community.

Members of the ESCC undertake a wide and interesting range of training and activities that foster self-reliance, teamwork, initiative, and a commitment to community service.

The ESCC was established in 1996. It embraces the operational and community service ideals of the Emergency Services – the State Emergency Service, Fire & Rescue Service, Bush Fire Service, Volunteer Marine Rescue Services and Community Safety.







The Parish of Beverley – Brookton

Throughout March we will be observing the Season of Lent, a time

characterised by self-examination, penitence, self-denial, study, and preparation for Easter. Lent runs for forty days, reminding us of the forty days that Jesus spent in the wilderness.

Stations of the Cross have formed part of Christian devotion at Passiontide for many centuries; they enable us to engage actively with the path of suffering walked by Jesus. They originated when early Christians visited Jerusalem and wanted to follow literally in the footsteps of Jesus, tracing the path from Pilate's house to Calvary. They would pause for prayer and devotion at various points.

Mothering Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Lent. In mediaeval times each year in the middle of Lent,

worshippers would visit their "mother" church - the main church or Cathedral of the area. Inevitably the return to the "mother" church became an occasion for family reunions when children who were working away returned home.

Services to honour the Feast of the Annunciation (Lady Day), the Patronal Festival of St Mary's Church, Beverley and Guildford Grammar School, will take place at Holy Trinity Church, York on Saturday, 25th March at 6 p.m. and at St Mary's Church, Beverley at 10 a.m. on Sunday, 26th March. At the service at Beverley our guest will be Archbishop Kay Goldsworthy.
