## **Shire of Beverley**

### **President Report – March 2016**

#### **Light Industrial Land**

Landcorp have been able to commence on the ground works for stage one of the DeLisle St light industrial development. Challenges and unexpected hurdles (mostly from associated government departments) have created delays, and continue to present. The Shire is appreciative of the opportunity to partner with Landcorp on this important project; resources would otherwise have been tested to the limit (as has been everyone's patience!)

#### **Age Friendly Community Plan**

Pending the outcome of a submission to the Department of Local Government and Communities Age Friendly Grant programme, it is proposed to develop an Age Friendly Community Plan for Beverley in the new financial year. This will guide Councils future planning and support funding applications for implementation.

#### **Footpath Replacement Programme**

Council has supported development of a 10 year Footpath Replacement Program. A full review and condition assessment of Councils Footpath Network was conducted in 2015 by Asset Infrastructure Management. Paths have been ranked based on their condition, construction materials and long term maintenance requirements. The plan will be reviewed annually and Council proposes to include an allocation of \$100,000 in the forthcoming budget. External funding will be sought where possible and the various plans being developed with support these applications.

#### **Roads**

Some shire roads required repair after heavy summer rain caused washouts in various locations. Many roads also required trees to be cleared following the storms. New bitumen has been completed on York Williams Rd, making a total of 7km new seal undertaken within the Shire in 15/16. (As a matter of interest, repairs were required (and a waste of ratepayers funds) to newly laid bitumen after someone cut it up in their vehicle, perhaps you have some information for the police?)

#### **Rubbish Bins**

Due to funding being cut and a priority focus on safety and maintenance, the Main Roads are reviewing the number of rubbish bins they are responsible for at rest stops. Shires are being offered the opportunity to take on the responsibility for some of these locations if they wish, at their own cost, and other bins will be removed. The Shire of Beverley already services bins in the Information Bay and at the Westdale Rd/Great Southern Highway intersection and propose to continue to do so, although the amount of household waste being left at the Westdale Rd/Great Southern Highway intersection is disappointing and could well see that bin removed in the future too.

#### **Register of Interest – BBP Aged Housing Project**

Please consider registering with the Shire if you are interested in age appropriate housing in Beverley. This is to gauge the need in our community for housing suitable to "aging in place" will assist future planning. The Beverley, Brookton & Pingelly (BBP) shires are currently working with the Wheatbelt Development Commission developing a Business Plan for Aged Housing in our communities. Contact the Shire Office as soon as possible to register. There are no obligations by doing so.

## BEVERLEY CORNERSTONE

### **(BEVERLEY MULTIPURPOSE COMMUNITY CENTRE)**

Council is continuing in its endeavours to seek funding to construct the Beverley Cornerstone project (formerly named Beverley Multipurpose Community Centre).

An application to Round 2 of National Stronger Regions Fund (Federal Government Funding) of \$1.9m was unsuccessful.

The Beverley Cornerstone project is included in the 2015/2016 budget at a cost of \$4m with grant funding already committed from:

Lotterywest	\$745,000
Dept of Regional Development, WA CRC Network Building and Infrastructure Fund	\$250,000
Beverley Community Resource Centre Inc	\$25,000

Shire of Beverley contributions are recognised in the 2015/2016 budget as:

Shire of Beverley Cropping Committee Reserve	\$260,000
Shire of Beverley New Loan 119	\$820,000

The Beverley Cornerstone project has been developed in response to changing needs for a facility that accommodates the requirements of the Beverley CRC and supports business development, tourism and not for profit sectors while addressing the social needs of the wider community. In addition, this construction supports recent changes to the Shire of Beverley Workforce Plan and a physical work environment that enables more efficient and effective service delivery.

The Beverley Cornerstone will be highly visible from the Great Southern Highway (Hunt Road) providing an aesthetically pleasing entry to the town centre and complimenting a civic precinct which includes the Vincent Street business and retail section of the townscape, the Shire of Beverley Administration Centre and Town and Lesser Halls.

Plans of the building will be displayed in the windows at the Administration Centre.

The funding application will be submitted in mid-March and outcomes of this application should be known by July 2016.

### **BEVERLEY WATER HARVEST PROJECT**

Rainfall records over the last 30 years indicate that the 10 year average annual rainfall has declined from 427mm in the 10 year period 1982 – 1993, to 417mm in the 10 year period 1994 – 2003, to 380mm in the 10 year period ended 2013.

To better prepare the community for periods of low rainfall and to cater for this declining average annual rainfall, the Beverley Water Harvest Project 2014-15 will enable construction of facilities for the harvesting and storage of water for community purposes.

Improvements to the Shire water supply were made by the Council in 1999 when a bore located west of the town centre was purchased. The Waterhatch Bore feeds into the town dam located downstream from the bore, supplementing the water supply for Shire activities and facilities.

Over a number of years the concept of harvesting street water to further supplement the water supply for these purposes has been investigated and reviewed by interested residents and the Shire of Beverley. In 2014, at the request of the community and the Shire staff, the Council engaged consultant engineer, Mr Rod Munn of RMECS, to investigate and construct a plan for the harvesting of storm water from particular town site streets. This plan was the basis of successful application to the Department of Water Community Water Supply Program for a grant of \$100,000.

This project aims to achieve real, visible and sustainable improvement in the water supply by allowing for “runoff (to) be stored for re-use as a second class water supply for irrigation” (2003/08, Curtin University, Department of Civil Engineering, Beverley Drainage Study).

The Beverley Water Harvest Project will involve construction of two retention basins that will capture storm water from town site streets and then, over a period of 4.9 days (at a full capacity of 3000m<sup>3</sup>), pump the water to the town dam. The basins will be sized to match a 30 – 40mm rainfall event at each location (similar to those events recently experienced in January 2016 in Beverley). The dams are located at the river end of Edwards Street and John Street.

The volume of water harvested will account for 70% of the Shire of Beverley water requirements for parks and gardens. Combined with the current water infrastructure within the town, including the town dam, the Waterhatch Bore and the soon to be commissioned Waste Water Treatment Plant, this project will enhance the town water supply by providing a more sustainable supply to meet the current and future needs of the Shire of Beverley with opportunities to extend the use of this non potable water to landholders via standpipe and for emergency services purposes.

Works being currently undertaken are lining the basin walls in plastic. This will be followed by trenching and laying new pipework back to the town dam.

The estimated completion date for construction is 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016.

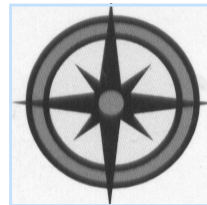

# Cleaning tips

## Other chemical residues

- ✓ Rinse container immediately after use as all chemical residues are much harder to remove when dry
- ✓ Some containers may require additional rinsing (more than three rinses)
- ✓ A brush or high pressure hose may be required to clean stubborn or dried chemical residue

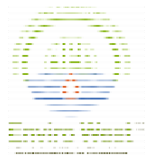

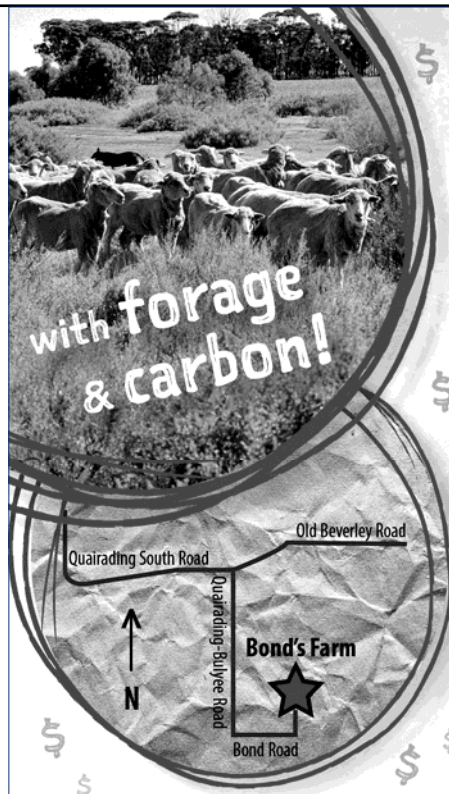

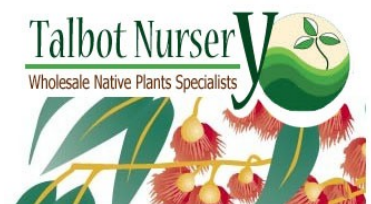

## Ovarian Cancer Awareness

It was estimated that ovarian cancer was the most common cause of death from gynaecological cancer in Australia during 2015, with approximately 1,020 deaths. In 2015, it was estimated that 1,460 cases of ovarian cancer would be diagnosed, making it the second most common gynaecological cancer in Australia.

While the survival rate for ovarian cancer has improved significantly in recent years, it still remains low in comparison with other gynaecological cancers.

Only 43 out of 100 women with ovarian cancer survive five years beyond their diagnosis.

### About ovarian cancer

The ovaries are two small, oval-shaped organs, each about 3 cm long and 1 cm thick. They are found in the lower part of the abdomen (the pelvic cavity). There is one ovary on each side of the uterus. Each ovary has an outer covering made up of a layer of cells called the epithelium. Inside are germ cells, which will eventually mature into eggs (ova). Ovarian cancer is the growth of abnormal cells in one or both ovaries. Left untreated, ovarian cancer can spread to other parts of the body.

### How common is it?

- Because it is difficult to detect in its early stages, there are more deaths from ovarian cancer than any other gynaecological cancer.
- In WA in 2011, 133 women were diagnosed with ovarian cancer and 81 died from the disease.
- The chances of a woman developing ovarian cancer by the time she is aged 85 (lifetime risk) is 1 in 78.
- Ovarian cancer is more common in women over 50. The average age at diagnosis is 63.

### Risk factors

The causes of ovarian cancer are not fully understood. However, there are a number of factors that are known to increase the risk of developing ovarian cancer - some of which are beyond your control, while others are not.

Known risk factors for ovarian cancer include:

- getting older: women over 50 are more likely to develop ovarian cancer than younger women
- inheriting a faulty gene (called a gene mutation) that increases the risk of ovarian cancer
- having a strong family history of ovarian cancer, breast cancer, or some other cancers, including bowel and endometrial cancer. It is important to remember that only around 5-10 per cent of all ovarian cancers are due to inherited factors

- endometriosis, which is when the tissue lining of the uterus (the endometrium) is found outside the uterus
- hormonal factors such as early puberty, late menopause or the long-term use of hormone replacement therapy (HRT)

**Lifestyle factors** are things you can do something about. Your risk of ovarian cancer is increased if you:

- smoke;
- are overweight or obese;
- don't exercise;
- have a poor diet;
- drink alcohol

### Symptoms

Ovarian cancer can be difficult to diagnose in its early stages as symptoms can be non-specific or similar to those of other diseases. Symptoms include:

- a swollen, bloated abdomen
- pressure, discomfort or pain in the abdomen
- heartburn, nausea and bloating
- changes in toilet habits (e.g. constipation, diarrhoea, frequent urination due to pressure, increased flatulence)
- tiredness and loss of appetite
- unexplained weight loss or weight gain
- changes in your menstrual pattern or postmenopausal bleeding
- pain during sex

If any of these symptoms are unusual for you, and they persist, it's important to see your doctor.

It is important to know these symptoms, but it is equally important to know ovarian cancer often develops without symptoms. What's more, having these symptoms does not mean you have ovarian cancer, as they may be caused by other conditions. However, if you do have any of these symptoms you should see your doctor as soon as possible.

# ChemClear ON ITS WAY TO WA



ChemClear is heading to Western Australia in June 2016 and is urging chemical users to register their surplus or unwanted agvet chemicals for safe disposal before 22 April 2016.

“We encourage WA farmers to seize the opportunity to use our program this year as it will be another two years before we head back across the Nullarbor,” said National Program Manager Lisa Nixon.

Since the program was established 16 years ago, ChemClear has undertaken five regional collection runs across Western Australia and retrieved in excess of 61 tonnes of obsolete agvet chemicals.

The program uses local council sites to collect from waste holders who have registered their chemicals for retrieval. The collection process is quick and easy, and waste holders are given an appointment time to meet the ChemClear retrieval team to drop off their registered chemicals for safe disposal.

“Our program operates like a milk run and visits every local government region that we have received a registration in, even if there is only one or a handful of waste holders in that area,” said Ms Nixon. “We are required to obtain licences for the transportation and removal of hazardous waste, therefore each waste holder must take an inventory of their obsolete chemicals before registering for the program.”

WAFarmers Chief Executive Officer Stephen Brown believes ChemClear is critical for maintaining a safe working environment for farmers.

“Our organisation is committed to ensuring farmers are provided with safe working environments and we're proud to support the ChemClear initiative which works towards this goal,” he said.

“Unused chemicals on rural properties can pose occupational safety and health risks for farmers, so we encourage all our members to work sustainably and dispose of obsolete chemicals through this environmentally safe method.”

ChemClear collects APVMA currently registered chemicals produced by 121 manufacturers supporting the Industry Waste Reduction Scheme. Chemicals classified as Group 1 are collected free of charge.

As an additional service, ChemClear collects what is classified as Group 2 chemicals. This category covers deregistered, out-of-date, mixed, unlabelled or unknown agvet chemicals produced by a manufacturer not signed to the ChemClear stewardship program.

There is a cost for disposal of Group 2 chemicals which is quoted to the waste holder once their registration has been processed.

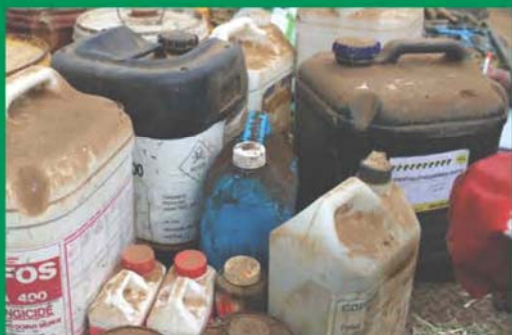

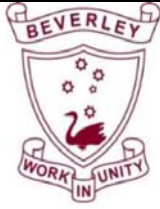

## New Canteen Manager

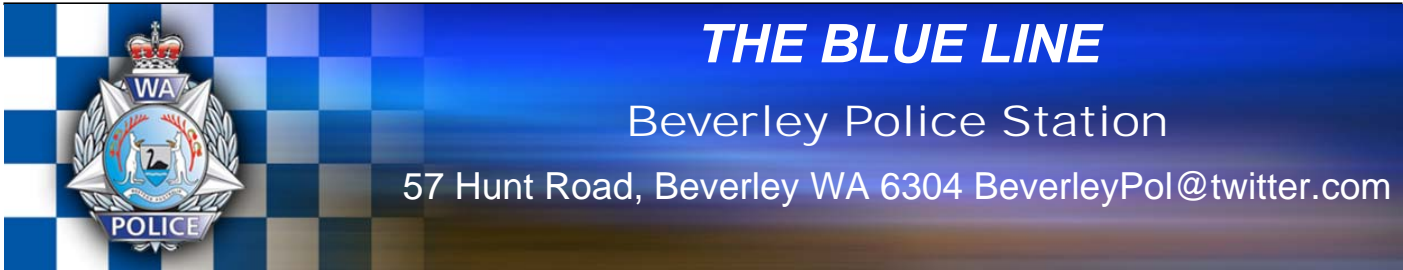

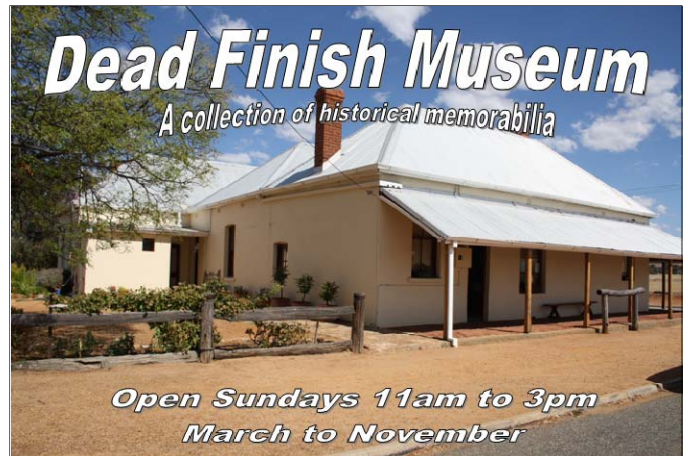

## What are computer viruses?

Computer viruses are very common. I find them on nearly every PC I handle. They range from annoying - slowing down your PC until it is practically useless; to the extremely malicious – stealing your identity and your money, or encrypting all the files on your PC and asking for a ransom. All of these have happened here in Beverley. These days it is absolutely necessary to have good virus protection on your device (PCs, tablets or phones) and good backup.

### Common Computer Virus Types

**Adware and spyware (annoying):** these viruses flood the device with unwanted adverts, pop-ups. These slow your device and entice you to click on ads to clean up your PC. This can lead to being offered unwanted and malicious services. Adware acts as entry point for more dangerous viruses.

**Worms (annoying and fast-spreading):** These are spread by infected e-mail attachments or malicious links in e-mails. If you open an attachment or click on the link the virus can hijack your contacts and send out emails to all your contacts. These flood the internet and can cause major congestion.

**Trojan (extremely dangerous):** a program is put on your device to steal your identity, e.g. personal details, passwords, and bank and credit card numbers. A Beverley customer nearly had a substantial sum stolen from their bank this way. Some Trojans create a backdoor to enter your device remotely to read/control your screen, keyboard, mouse, etc.

**Crypto Viruses (extremely dangerous):** Criminals enter your PC, usually using a Trojan, and deposit a program to encrypt all their files so they are unusable, then demand a ransom to restore the files. If you don't pay, your files will be lost forever. Even if you pay there is no guarantee getting your

## The Nastiest Virus on the Internet

A client in Beverley had an old XP PC that was infected with **Cryptowall**. Criminals encrypted all their files so they are unusable, then demanded a ransom to restore their files. They decided not to pay and lost all their files as they had no backup:

files back - you are dealing with untraceable criminals.

**Look up "computer virus classification" on the Internet to find more information on computer viruses.**

### Protecting Against Viruses

**Virus detectors:** It is absolutely essential to have a virus detection program to prevent viruses getting on your device. There are very good ones available free – so no excuse!

**Virus scanners:** Virus detectors don't stop everything so a regular scan of all your files is necessary. Use a separate scanner – if the virus detector lets a virus through then scanning with the same program will not find the virus. The best scanner is free, so again no excuses.

**Don't click:** Avoid clicking on anything you are not sure about on web pages. If it looks suspicious it probably is! Beware of adverts buried in the text. If the web address is not the same as the web page, be very wary.

**Avoid spam emails:** Not all spam emails are filtered out. Delete any suspicious emails. Do not open attachments or click on links unless absolutely sure the sender is genuine.

**Disconnect/shutdown:** if something suspicious is happening on your device disconnect or shut down. This will prevent further damage. Get help if required.

**Regular backups** to an *external* drive or to the 'cloud' are the only way to guarantee not losing your files when something goes wrong. **Disconnect your backup drive when not in use - it can be encrypted by a crypto virus.** If you can't backup to the cloud and don't have an external back-up hard drive, buy one. A 1 Terabyte drive costs about \$80 in the Beverley Post Office or available online or at other stores.

**Take all updates:** Keep your device up to date. Most updates are to repair security holes. Also update virus protection programs – there are new viruses every day. If your device is no longer supported, scrap it, it is a security liability. Scrap any PC with Windows XP or earlier. Support for XP ceased in 2014.
