Shire President Notes for April 2026 Blarney

Beverley Airshow 11 April 2026 – in addition to the huge amount of organisation happening behind the scenes in preparation for the Airshow, the Shire's work crew and Beverley Soaring Society have been preparing the grounds at and around the airfield. In the week leading up to the Airshow there will be much activity setting up for the event, including arrival of the Silver Centenary and a practice RAAF flypast.

Burning Restrictions – there will be no burning permitted in the Shire on Friday 10th and Saturday 11th April 2026, the restriction has been applied under Section 46 of the Bush Fires Act 1954. Please take note that as the Shire moves into the "unrestricted" burning period there may be times when a ban is still applied under Section 46 regulations.

Fuel – the current situation regarding fuel stocks, availability and cost is concerning, particularly for the farming sector about to commence seeding programmes. At the time of writing the Shire had less than 2 weeks supply for normal operations, requiring a review of current works when expected deliveries didn't occur.

Fuel theft is an emerging issue and we need to remain vigilant across the district. Our local police are very aware of the situation; saying any information is useful and requesting that it be reported. Already one of the Shire graders has been vandalised and drained of fuel.

Bridges – annual bridge inspections are being carried out and some preventative work undertaken on several. Having older bridges all over the Shire, which when built catered for much lighter traffic than is on the roads today, is a huge concern for rural local governments, not the least ours. We do not want to see bridges being closed or weight restricted because adequate funding is not provided by state and federal governments to keep them fit for purpose.

There is consideration for speed restriction on Bridge 3202 at the western end of Kokeby East Rd due to damage from trucks breaking just before or on the bridge prior to entering Great Southern Highway. The Shire has been lobbying for funding for this bridge over many years to no avail.

Swimming Pool – not much more to say about the pool other than hoorah! Everyone seems to be enjoying the refurbishment; our local community, our pool manager, and I'm told many visitors to town. It looks fantastic and although Western Power are yet to undertake an upgrade, it will remain open over Easter this year.

Citizenships – a citizenship ceremony was conducted at the Civic Centre on 9th March 2026; we welcome our newest Australian Citizen Angela Read.

The Department of Home Affairs are responsible for Immigration and Citizenship and has accepted dates set aside should future citizenships be requested to be held in Beverley, those dates being Friday 3 July and Friday 6 November. Whilst there is flexibility for these to change, Citizenships are required to be held outside of Federal and State Parliamentary sitting dates.

Road Hazards – a trip to Perth early Sunday to help on the Avon Valley stand at the recent Caravan and Camping Show again displayed the expedient generosity of local farmers regarding road hazards which could seriously impact community safety. On Westdale Rd about 11km Perth side of the Dale Hall a fallen tree completely blocked the road, easily seen when coming from Beverley but not so when travelling from the other direction. It was immensely dangerous. Being early on a Sunday and with dreadful phone coverage it was difficult to relay the issue. A trip through the paddock bypassing the hazard to get help revealed that the farmer had already left and was on site with a large loader clearing the road. Thankyou!

DON'T LET YOUR FIRE BECOME THE GREAT ESCAPE!

The Community Emergency Services Manager along with the Bush Fire Control Officers for the Shire of Beverley would like to remind everyone to take **all care** when deciding to conduct any form of burning and to be **well prepared** to prevent the fire escaping your control.

It is always the responsibility of the person who conducts a burn to ensure that the fire does not escape their control and penalties and sanctions including fines and/or the recovery of the costs associated with local Bush Fire Brigade response can apply where a fire escapes and impacts others.

The following is a list of factors to consider when conducting burning...

- What are the current weather conditions particularly relating to wind strength and direction? (no burning if the wind is likely to exceed 20kmh) Can you postpone your burn to a better day?
- What are the forecast wind conditions for the following days? Is the weather forecast to turn bad?
- Do you have sufficient resources available to prevent an escape of your fire?
 - If you live in town have you made sure that you have a hose or hoses that can easily reach the site of your fire and beyond? Have you checked that the water is turned on and ready immediately if required?
 - Have you cleared a bare mineral earth break around the area to be burnt? Do you have rakes and shovels immediately available to use?
 - Are you dressed appropriately with long pants and long sleeved cotton clothing, sturdy boots and leather gloves?
 - Have you ensured that your fire is a sufficient distance from trees, shrubs or anything else you don't wish to burn? Remember flames heights can be considerably higher than your rubbish pile and radiant heat can set fire to surrounding items. Maintain a minimum of 5 metres clear for small garden fires. Wet down surrounding areas.
 - If you are outside of town do you have an adequate number of fire fighter units to control the burn? Have pumps, motors and hoses been checked to ensure immediate operation and water supply when required? Has a bare mineral earth firebreak been installed around the paddocks you wish to burn as per the Shire's Firebreak Order?
 - Do you have a sufficient number of people organised to monitor the fire and maintain supervision until it is fully extinguished? **DO NOT LEAVE A FIRE BURNING UNATTENDED.**

A Section 46 (S46) Prohibition of Burning can be declared by the Shire at any time when forecast weather conditions could mean the risk of fire escaping is unacceptable. If a S46 is declared all burning is prohibited for the period specified. Penalties up to \$10,000 can apply to anyone breaching a S46 declaration.

🔥 Burning Prohibited – Temporary Ban in Place 🔥

The Shire of Beverley and the Chief Bush Fire Control Officer have declared a Section 46 Bushfires Act prohibition on all burning.

 From: Midnight, Friday 10 April 2026

 To: Midnight, Saturday 11 April 2026

This temporary ban is in place due to the Beverley Air Show.

 No burning is permitted during this time.

This includes all forms of open-air burning.

We appreciate the community's cooperation in ensuring a safe and successful event.



Beverley Aviation Timeline

Compiled by Beverley Historical Society 2026

1929	Selby Ford & his cousin, Tom Shackles, commence building an airplane in the Beverley Power House, Dawson St, from a design marked out with chalk on the floor.
1930	The aircraft named Silver Centenary flies successfully from Benson's Field (opposite the Dead Finish) with Captain Nesbit as the pilot.
1932	Joy flights in a Gypsy Moth with Captain Snook & a parachute jump by Lt Reece at Benson's Field.
1934	Beverley Aerodrome officially opens on land adjacent to the wheat bin with 1 Dragon, 1 Spartan & 3 Moth planes in attendance. Miss Rance of the Aero Club gave a display of loops & stalled turns. Joy flights were available for spectators.
1939	Avro Anson bomber from Pearce Air Base lands at Beverley aerodrome.
WW2	Plane spotting operations carried out by local volunteers in Beverley & Bally Bally. Volunteer Defence Corps receive training in the use of an anti-aircraft gun.
1942	Commonwealth War Department approves construction of a new airfield across the river from the old aerodrome.
1944	The airfield consisting of 2 intersecting runways and taxiways to house 18 camouflaged planes is complete.
1945	VDC (home guard) use airfield for training.
1967	An Aeronautical Museum in Vincent St officially opens as a memorial to Selby Ford. The Silver Centenary is the centrepiece of the display.

1960s	Silver Centenary is used as the centre of the new insignia for the Shire of Beverley.
1968	Beverley Flying Club established.
1970	Aviat 70 airshow celebrates 50 years of flying in WA. Vampire Air Frame, purchased from Pearce, arrives in Beverley.
1973	Gliding commences at Beverley. The Beverley Soaring Society is formed the following year.
1974	Air Pageant 74 includes a low-level bypass of a passenger Boeing 747.
1984	Air Display celebrating 50 years of Airlines of Western Australia with RAAF formation flying.
2000	Air Show marked the 70th Anniversary of first flight of the Silver Centenary.
2005	RAAF Hercules transport aircraft uses Beverley Airfield for commando-style training exercises.
2009	Silver Centenary, newly repaired, flies from Jandakot to land at Beverley Airfield.
2018	Cornerstone building is erected on the site of the old Aeronautical Museum with a large-scale model of the Silver Centenary.
2026	Beverley Air Show with visiting aircraft, aerobatic display, gliders & model aircraft.

Beverley Historical Society & Dead Finish Museum Notes

- The Dead Finish Museum on the corner of the Great Southern Highway and Morrison St, Beverley is now open for the 2026 season from March to November. The price of entry is now \$5.00.
- A great deal of preparation is carried out by Beverley Historical Society members and community professionals to get the Dead Finish Museum ready after the summer closure. Displays were uncovered & covers packed away. The verandahs were hosed & the seats moved outside. Professional cleaners dusted, wiped, cleaned glass cabinets and vacuumed floors. Windows were cleaned inside & out by local tradesmen. Curtains, tablecloths & doilies were washed & ironed. The floors will be professionally re-conditioned when the weather is cooler.
- Our first general meeting of the year was held on 9 March with a good roll-up. Some members had spent the morning on an interesting field trip to the Beverley Commonage.
- Donations to the Museum in recent weeks have included items associated with the Beverley Airfield & other matters of aviation connected to the town.
- Archive records include a sketch plan, drawn in the 1960s, of the generators on the floor of the Beverley Power House, Dawson St. Does anyone know who drew this?

BEVERLEY AGRICULTURAL MUSEUM.

After surviving the summer heat, our volunteers got together again in March to continue our work with maintenance and restoration to the vast number of items in the Shire of Beverley's collection.

Some of our groups have been attending on a regular basis during the warmer months and have been delighted when visitors have arrived unexpectedly (normally closed due to the summer fire risk) thus giving them the opportunity to share (and sometimes extend) their knowledge with the public.

Much progress (and effort) has been placed on the restoration of the International C30 Truck, with the brakes being totally dismantled, wheel bearings repacked and new hydraulic parts being fitted, also the front bonnet and side panels now away to be sand blasted before being painted to match the new mudguards and rebuilt wooden cabin, your efforts John H, Paul, Barry and others has been much appreciated.

An item which has caused us a few headaches was the FX Holden Ute, over the past two years much effort has been placed on getting this vehicle back into reliable running condition, so once the brakes were finally working, it was extremely demoralising for the group when the starter motor failed (and was given its 'last rights' by our local Mechanic) and with a new or good condition replacement being far too costly, we are grateful to Bruce Mann for his kind contribution of Holden parts, thanks naturally go out to all concerned in that restoration group, Gerry, Tim, Eric, John H and John A.

With our extended workshop, Gerry has been 'fine tuning' the contents, making it easier for everyone to access and find what they need, and naturally identification of items is slowing the process a little given many 'parts' are older than we are. A big thank you to the Beverley Men's Shed for their contribution of duplicated hand tools recently.

Tim has often stopped working on his projects in the past to start and run the 'Southern Cross' stationary engine for visitors, which has been fairly reliable until it suddenly stopped for no real reason, its okay and running again, but given our lack of 'total knowledge' of this item a repair/handbook has been acquired to assist with the maintenance and repairs.

With so many items in our collection and many being donated nearly 50 years ago, a lot of information is 'missing' about our collection, technical 'stuff' can be easily obtained via the internet, but those personal stories often hold more value for the visitors, e.g, the day our Tractor back fired and the air was blue----and not from the smoke! Or when that harvester found a rock and tried to 'grind' it up! If you have something to share why not come out and visit us, we are all about the history.

Our opening times in April are **Easter Saturday & Monday** (closed Easter Sunday), volunteer operation days this month are **Saturday 11** (also **Air Show Day**) **Sunday 12 & Saturday 25** (**Anzac Day**), with a **special opening weekend on 18 & 19** for the 'plein air' artists, the public are also very welcome to take advantage of this opportunity.
