## SHIRE OF BEVERLEY PRESIDENT'S REPORT



### Vincent Street Streetscape Project

Thank you again to the community and local businesses for your patience during the construction works.

Stormwater drainage installation is progressing well along Vincent Street. Profiling of Vincent Street and carparks (Men's Shed and Station) is scheduled for Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022 (mobilization) and Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2022 (works). We have arranged that at least one lane will remain open along Vincent Street during this time.

There will be times when the entire street will have to be closed (with detours along e.g. Elizabeth Street, Queen Street, John Street) for planned works cutting across the road. The timing of these is still unknown but will be communicated to the Shire closer to the time of construction commencing.

**These will be posted on the Shire's Website and Social Media Platforms.**

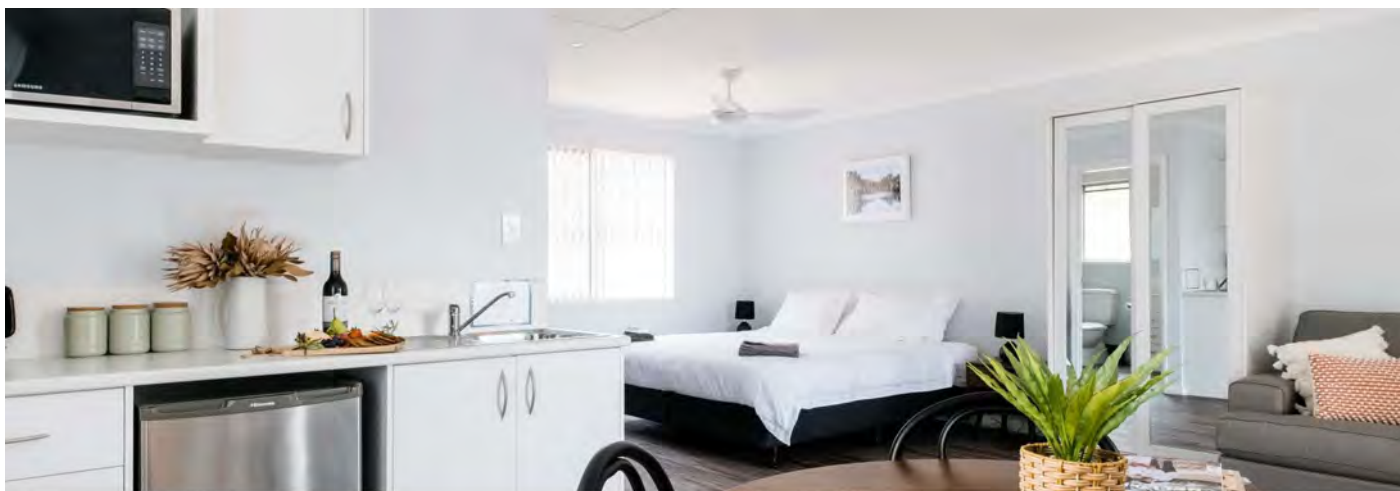

## P. C. Doherty – a Courteous Constable



Patrick William Doherty was born in Ireland in 1855. His brown eyes, black hair and a fresh complexion were recorded on appointment to the Western Australian Constabulary in May 1883. He was 5ft 9in in height.

He married Susan Cleverly at about the same time and they eventually had nine children, seven of whom were born in Beverley. Their fourth child a girl named Jannette lived only a couple of months in 1888. The family were Roman Catholic and the closest Catholic church then was in York. It is possible that baby Janette was buried there.

PC Doherty began his service in Perth, then in November 1884 he was appointed Officer-in-Charge to Beverley. PC Doherty replaced PC Hackett who had been cruelly bashed to death just a few weeks before.

PC Doherty, his wife and growing family would have resided in the Police Station & Post Office building on the corner of Elizabeth St & Hunt Rd. Built in 1868 this building was demolished in 1928

As the children reached school age they would have attended the Old Schoolhouse in Vincent St (on the site of the present Shire offices) until the new brick school was opened next door in 1894.

Apart from his official duties PC Doherty interested himself in community affairs. In February 1893 at the opening of the new Wesleyan Church it was noted in the *Eastern Districts Chronicle*: "Special mention should be made of P.C. Doherty, who did so much in collecting subscriptions."

In June 1896 Patrick Doherty was promoted to Corporal. Then after 12 years in Beverley he was transferred in September 1896 as Officer-in-Charge at North Fremantle.

The *Chronicle* in August 1896 reported:

**On Friday last the residents of Beverley and district presented Corporal Doherty with a purse of sovereigns and testimonial prior to his departure for North Fremantle, to which place he has been transferred. Mr. Thomas Edwards, in making the presentation, spoke in eulogistic terms of Corporal Doherty's many good qualities, who he stated had always displayed great tact and common sense in the performance of his duties. His residence in Beverley had been a long one, and he felt sure that he was expressing the sentiments of the whole community when he said that the Corporal's departure would be a loss to the district. He wished Corporal Doherty every success in the future. Messrs T. S. Lodge, W. Smith, E. Powell, Whitely, and Dr. Blanchard also spoke of the Corporal's good qualities. Corporal Doherty thanked them for their kindness, and was pleased to hear so many kind remarks. He had always tried to do his duty, and was glad that he had given some satisfaction.**

**Corporal Doherty was a most painstaking and courteous officer in the constabulary, and the capable manner in which he performed his duties won the appreciation of the general public.**

BEVERLEY TOWN HALL – MONDAY 14 FEBRUARY 2022

A previous runaway success in London's West End, at successive Edinburgh Festivals, at the Melbourne Comedy Festival and right across the USA, this is a hilarious send-up of classical music, which has established Australian pianist, David Scheel, as the successor to the legendary Victor Borge.

Beautiful music, and musical fun performed in so many accents/voices that David has also been compared to the late Robin Williams, and Peter Ustinov. 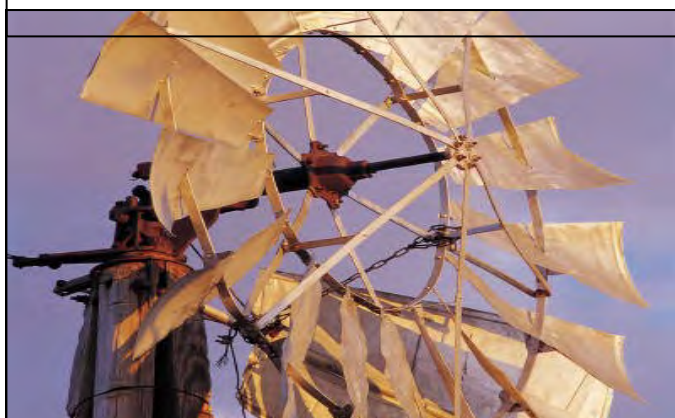

# Beverley Tree & Garden Society

Firstly, I must apologise for sending to the Blarney, the incorrect results of the 2021 Rose Show. Those shown were from 2020 and I am very sorry for any dismay it caused. Congratulations to the very deserving winners of the various categories.

## TREE & GARDEN SOCIETY

The last meeting for 2021 was replaced by our Christmas lunch which was held at the Greenhills Inn. We set off in several cars and were soon seated in the lovely "Queen's Room" where the air-conditioning was working well. The traditional meal was very generous as were the desserts that followed. The Secret Santa revealed a great variety of lovely gifts.

The next meeting will be held on Tuesday the 1<sup>st</sup> of March at 10.30am at Valery Seeber's home. We will meet at the Dead Finish at 10am so those who don't know the way can follow the leader. Please bring a chair.

Gardening in Beverley during January can be challenging dealing with the heat waves and strong, hot winds.

Vegetables to plant in January include: beans, beetroot, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrot, cauliflower, leek, lettuce, radish, rhubarb, shallots, silverbeet, spring onion and turnip,

Flowers to plant in January include: alyssum, aster, dahlia, gerbera, impatiens, marigold, nasturtium, pansy, petunia, portulaca, salvia, stock, sweet pea, verbena and zinnia.

January is a great time to attend to the following tasks in the garden:

- Divide bromeliads
- Trim hedges and espaliered plants to maintain good shape
- Dead head roses to encourage more flowers
- Tip prune basil regularly to encourage bushy plants
- Top up mulch on everything – including pot plants – to help retain moisture in the soil
- Check your worm farm regularly to ensure it does not dry out
- Tip prune native shrubs that have finished flowering to help make them bushier
- Harvest fruit, vegetables and herbs daily
- Clean out excess plants from your pond
- Remove suckers from grafted plants, especially citrus, robinia and roses
- Prevent seeds forming on agapanthus by removing spent flowers
- Prune roses by one third to encourage good flowering for autumn
- Remove a third of developing fruit on trees to reduce disease, increase fruit size and quality and to evenly distribute the weight of the fruit
- Cut back lemon verbena, mint and lemon balm so they don't become leggy. Use the prunings to flavour drinks
- Remove dead leaves from tropical plants such as palms, cordyline, strelitzia, ginger and bromeliad and strappy plants such as kangaroo paw
- With a chance of summer storms, January is a good time to ask a qualified arborist to check all trees and remove any dangerous branches

RFDS WA Chief Executive Officer Rebecca Tomkinson said, "The helicopters will work alongside the existing fleet of 20 fixed-wing aircraft to ensure the RFDS can continue to provide the best possible care for patients living, working and travelling in rural and remote communities.

"The RFDS is proud to be partnering with Fortescue to provide this service for Western Australians. We remain absolutely committed to our century-old promise to improve health equity for people living in remote and regional communities.

"The helicopters will enable many patients to get a faster journey to hospital. In what has been the busiest year in our history, having additional capability in our fleet is vitally important to our life-saving service.

"It is my absolute privilege to be part of the Royal Flying Doctor Service in WA as we take this new and exciting step forward and I would like to sincerely thank Fortescue for their support, without which this new service wouldn't be possible," Ms Tomkinson said.

A team of RFDS doctors and nurses are currently undergoing training to care for patients being transferred by helicopter, before the helicopters officially go into service in early 2022.

## About the Fortescue Heli-Med Service

- The Fortescue Heli-Med Service (the Service) will serve regional communities including Bunbury, Jurien Bay, Northam, Narrogin and Margaret River, as well as destinations as close to Perth as Rottnest Island and the Peel region

The RFDS have recruited rotary pilots and engineers to work on the helicopters and teams of specialist clinical staff are undergoing comprehensive training in readiness for the assets to be integrated into the fleet in early 2022.

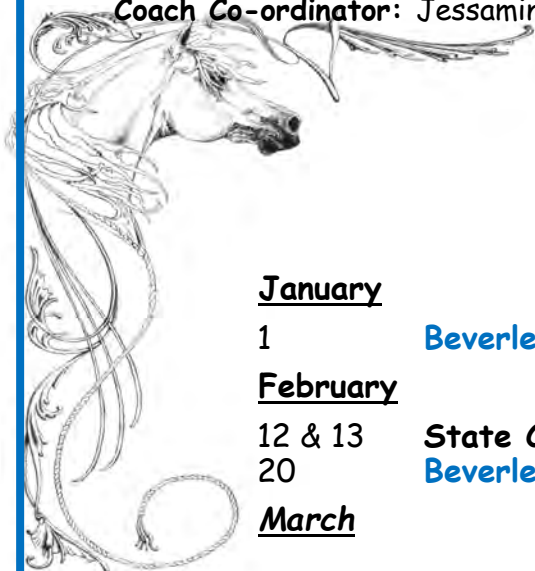
