DISCOUNT ON RATES 2022/23.

As I reported in the July Blarney, the method of providing the 10% discount on rates for the 2022/23 financial year has changed.

Rates Notices will formally be sent out on 8th August 2022 so please mark this date to expect your notice. For ratepayers to take advantage of the 10% discount, rates MUST be PAID BY FRIDAY 29th AUGUST 2022.

The latest date upon which the rates are due to be paid to avoid interest being charged is Friday 12th September 2022 but the discount is NOT available between these two dates.

PLEASE READ YOUR RATE NOTICE CAREFULLY WHEN YOU RECEIVE IT IN AUGUST 2022.

Rates for 2022/2023

At the Council meeting of Tuesday 26th July, the Budget was approved with a rate increase of 5%. This may seem significant given that in recent years the Council has been able to keep increases to below 3%. While there was a 5% increase last year, this had to cover the rate freeze in 2019/2020.

The 5% increase for the current financial year needs to be kept in perspective in light of inflation rising to 7% for WA in March quarter. It is anticipated that this figure may well increase when the figures for the June quarter are published.

Planned Upgrade to the Swimming Pool and facilities.

In the July Blarney I outlined the situation with respect to the Swimming Pool redevelopment. At the latest costing of \$11,000,000, the project will not proceed unless significant Grant Funding becomes available, and even then, probably not in its current form. I did receive a query from a resident concerning the pool and was asked why an awning could not be placed over the pool which might attract more patronage.

Just to illustrate the cost of doing anything with the Pool, an indicative quote to put shade cloth over the entire pool was \$164,000. This will not be happening.

Vincent Street Streetscape Project

What might be seen as the bane of everyone's' life does have an end date! At this point it is expected to be 12th September 2022!

The current steps in the project are:

1. Street lights were powered up on Monday 18th July;
2. Centre median strips for gardens has been completed;
3. Line marking for the carparks was scheduled for 26th July;
4. The asphalt at the Forrest/Vincent Street intersection was laid with the incorrect material **and will be relayed at the contractor's expense when the final seal is completed for Vincent Street;**
5. Street trees are expected to be delivered on 5th August with planting to commence soon after; and,
6. Furniture installation, 'Wombat' crossings, and landscaping to be completed over the period of August.

The priority is to have a presentable street for the '*Spring Back to Beverley*' event on 24th September.



What to do: If you are an existing Shire of Beverley Bush Fire Brigade Volunteer please email your name and Brigade to the Shire's Community Emergency Services Manager (CESM) troy.granville@beverley.wa.gov.au to confirm initial registration.

Why: This course is the minimum training competency standard considered to be compliant with the new Workplace Health & Safety Act 2021. This will attempt to alleviate the implications of severe financial penalties (up to \$10 million dollars) and potential criminal charges that could be imposed upon the Shire should a health or safety incident occur during a fire emergency in Beverley

- If you wish to sign up to a Shire of Beverley BFB, (Avondale, Beverley Central, Beverley South East, Beverley North East, Dale/Kokeby, Dale West) please email your name to the same email address.
- Along with minimum training requirements all persons attending active firegrounds will be required to meet the minimum dress standards of long trousers, long sleeves and boots. Volunteer BFB members are issued with Personal Protective Clothing that can be collected from the Shire when required.

A Visit to “Stump Jump” Smith’s House

Last month, members of the Beverley Historical Society were privileged to be invited to view the house in Lukin St built by Richard Bowyer Smith, the co-inventor of the Stump Jump Plough.

The Stump Jump Plough was invented in South Australia's Yorke Peninsula by brothers, Richard Bowyer (RB) & Clarence Herbert Smith, in their family's blacksmith workshop.

In 1884, Richard & his family moved to Western Australia and settled in Beverley where RB attempted to promote the revolutionary plough to the farmers of the state. Unable to make a profit with this venture, RB turned his attention to other forms of income. He became the licensee & manager of the Beverley Railway Refreshment Rooms, and took up a farming lease on the east side of the river. Then in 1899 he was the licensee for what was then named the 'Settlers Arms' hotel in Hunt Rd. This was a short-lived enterprise and lasted only a year. However, it was RB Smith who changed its name to the 'Beverley Hotel'.

He also opened a Coffee Palace in Vincent St, a chaff-cutting venture and continued to offer blacksmithing services. He was quite a successful farmer, cultivating cereals and tending stock such as sheep, pigs & poultry.

He was very involved in community affairs in the 1890s, being Chairman of the Roads Board, a member of the Municipal Council, Chair of the Mechanics Institute, and on the committees of the Agricultural Society & the Race Club. In 1908 he was an unsuccessful candidate in the Western Australian parliamentary elections.

RB Smith built his house in the late 19th Century

and named it “Marylea” after his mother, Mary Lee.

He built the house using locally made bricks, timber and iron. The house had no foundations and was built directly on to the ground, possibly re-using machine packing materials. Some of the internal wall linings are of metal. A shed roof still has a US Steel “Apollo” mark, while the back of an internal wall has the iconic Australian Lysaght “Queens Head” trademark stencil.

Beverley Ag Museum News

With our Ag Museum back open to the public now, it was pleasing to have visitors again on Saturday July 16 when our crew were busy with maintenance and repairs.

Two gentlemen from Bally Bally came in on a long-awaited revisit spending a considerable amount of time looking at our collection, after a while they reapproached the entrance as if leaving, I asked if they had seen everything, and was told they were methodically navigating the walk areas ensuring they did not miss a thing, (which can be easy to do) and proceeded to spend nearly another hour there. Our other visitors were staying at the National Trust Cottages, a Lady and three young boys (who were earlier seen enjoying the fresh air and riding their bikes in the area) who also enjoyed the exhibits.

Our usual team attended, plus Bill who had travelled up from Perth, (a friend of Kevin's) and came to assist with his expertise with the repairs to the fuel system of the Field Marshall, the leaking system could well be a contributor to how hard she is to start by both methods, diesel fuel leaking out (something no one can afford these days) and air getting into the system.

Paul had not only ensured the starter for the International C30 Truck was working okay but had also given it a coat of Primer paint and applied a topcoat of Black on site, the next step is to replace the battery electrical cables and starter switch, slowly but securely we are heading towards starting her up.

A big thank you to Peter (partner of the National Trust Warden Robyn) for his professional Carpentry efforts enclosing the Electrical Fuse Box, hopefully soon the Fuses will be updated with RCD's (Residual Current Device) a necessity with the buildings age.

Benefit Fund Update

Benefit Fund membership fees have now been set for the 2022/2023 financial year, with these being:

Family Membership: \$101.00

Single Membership: \$61.00

These memberships cover you (and your family for family memberships) for all Ambulance transport within WA, 24 hours a day and 7 days a week for 12 months.

With interstate travel now freely available, we wish to advise that WA does NOT have reciprocal agreements with all states for Ambulance transport:

- ◆ ACT, Queensland and SA do NOT have any agreement with St John WA, so unless you have private cover or travel insurance, any ambulance transport costs that you may incur will be your responsibility.
- ◆ NSW, NT, Victoria and Tasmania do have reciprocal arrangements with St John WA for those with Benefit Fund memberships. If you require ambulance transport in these states, you will most likely receive an invoice. However, if you have an up-to-date membership, we will be able to assist you in having this invoice written off.

Please note that for aged pensioners there are some variations to these general guidelines. Should you have any queries regarding reciprocal arrangements, please feel free to contact us.

TREE & GARDEN SOCIETY

The June meeting was replaced by a visit to the Perth Zoological Gardens which was greatly enjoyed by those who attended.

Unfortunately, the July Senior Members' lunch has been postponed until later in the year due to unforeseen circumstances and will now be held on the 1st of November.

Members discussed the display for the Beverley Agricultural Show and a lovely appliquéd wall hanging made by our late member, Colleen McAdam, will be used as a backdrop. Old (antique) gardening implements are needed to add to the theme of "Looking Back in Time". We will also be having a display of cups and saucers so if you have any hiding in your cupboards, bring them along ensuring that you have your name on them.

Now on to the annual Rose Show. Please consider entering some blooms even if you only have a few that you might feel are "ordinary". Pruning should soon be under way and here are some tips to help if you are unsure.

- ◆ Remove any dead, damaged and diseased growth, right at the base. You might need loppers or even a saw for this. In most cases this might mean you are removing 1 – 3 of the oldest bits of growth.
- ◆ Remove any inward facing limbs to reduce congestion and improve air and light penetration. This helps to prevent the most common rose ailments, fungal diseases like black spot and mildew.
- ◆ Most roses are grafted plants, meaning the flowering top is attached to a tough and adaptable root stock. Any vigorous growth coming from below the graft needs to be removed or it will take over. Roses also produce sappy, vigorous growth but from above the graft. These are known as water shoots; they are healthy growth that will form flowering stems so can be pruned with the rest of the plant to become a future framework.
- ◆ Once you are happy with your healthy rose growth, reduce the overall size by at least 1/3 to 1/2. Prune just above an outward facing bud as this will direct the growth in that direction and keep the plant open and airy.

Now, you can walk away at this point but there are a couple of things that will turn your well pruned roses into even better bloomers.

- ◆ Cleaning up now will prevent many problems later. Rake up old foliage and mulch to remove any fungal spores or pests on them.
- ◆ Roses are heavy feeders through the growing months of spring and summer, particularly for repeat flowering varieties. In winter after pruning, feed the soil. Top dress with a 2- 5 cm layer of well-rotted manure or compost. A monthly application of a small amount of a balanced, organic fertiliser from spring through to autumn will also benefit the blooms.
- ◆ Apply a fresh layer of organic mulch. Not only will it keep the moisture in over summer but it will also help prevent fungal spores that can cause things like black spot or rust from splashing up and reinfesting your clean rose. You can also spray with an organic fungicide like lime sulphur to kill off any spores.
- ◆ Once you have pruned and pampered, it is worth checking any stakes and supports. As the flowering part is grafted high above the ground level, ensure the stake comes into the head of the rose and secure at multiple points.
- ◆ As spring kicks in, it is worth keeping a keen eye on the growth. Taking spent blooms off or even picking stems for a vase will encourage more, just make sure you snip above a bit of growth.
- ◆ Keep an eye out for any fungi on the leaves and as soon as you spot them, whip them off to

The Commemoration of the Martyrs of New Guinea recalls with thanksgiving not only Anglican missionaries, but over three hundred missionaries of all denominations, who having remained at their posts during the Second World War were executed by the invading Japanese Imperial Army. When during the War the Japanese Imperial Army threatened Papua and New Guinea, it was obvious that missionaries of European origin would be in particular danger. There was talk of leaving the country. Bishop Philip Strong, the Anglican Bishop of New Guinea, wrote to his clergy, almost all of whom were of European origin "We must endeavour to carry on our work. God expects this of us. The Church at home, which sent us out, will surely expect it of us. The universal Church expects it of us. The people whom we serve expect it of us. We could never hold up our faces again if, for our own safety, we forsook Him and fled, when the shadows of the Passion began to gather around Him in his spiritual and mystical body, the Church in Papua." They stayed, and on 2nd September, 1942 eight Anglican clergymen and two Anglican laypeople were executed by the Japanese "as an

example". .

Elsewhere in the Avon Valley local Anglican Parishes are hosting events which may be of interest to residents of the Shire of Beverley. On Thursday, 11th August, Jesus: A Life in Class Conflict will be a Public Lecture delivered by Dr Robert Myles, Senior Lecturer in New Testament at Wollaston Theological College, Perth, and the University of Divinity at 6 p.m. in Holy Trinity Church York. Dr Myles is the author or editor of several books including Jesus: A Life in Class Conflict (2023), Class Struggle in the New Testament (2019), Sexuality, Ideology, and the Bible (2015), and The Homeless Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew (2014). All are welcome and admission is free.

Mary, Mother of our Lord is the Patronal Festival of St Mary's Anglican Girls' School in Perth. It is celebrated on Monday, 15th August. 


