# SHIRE OF BEVERLEY PRESIDENT'S REPORT



## CEO Recruitment

Under changes to the Local Government Act, Councils must advertise the position of CEO once the incumbent CEO has reached the end of a ten-year contract. This is the case in Beverley where Mr. Stephen Gollan will come to the end of his current contract on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

Applications for this position closed on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May. At the time of writing this Report, the Recruitment Panel met on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> May to discuss applications and make a recommendation to the full Council at its meeting on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> May.

Only one application was received. As a result, the Recruitment Panel has sent a recommendation to the Council that Mr. Stephen Gollan be reappointed to the position commencing 27<sup>th</sup> January 2026 under a contract and for a period to be determined by the Council.

I would like to thank Mr. Lew Shaw who accepted the position of Independent Person to the Panel, and Mrs. Lydia Highfield acting as a Consultant to the Council. Mrs. Highfield's guidance during the process was very much valued and appreciated.

Looking back on the need to comply with this legislation I would observe that it was an utter waste of time and money. The State Government needs to understand that Councils have the complete authority to engage and dismiss CEOs as the circumstances dictate. Just as a CEO has a right to resign. Attempting to limit tenure of a CEO by legislation is denying the integrity of Councils, Councilors and CEOs.

## Art Deco & Modernist Society Visit

On Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2025 the *Art Deco & Modernist Society* visited Beverley and completed a heritage walk along Vincent Street. They specifically requested access to the Beverley Town Hall. I met with the group in company with Stefan De Beer on the day. They were all familiar with the Town Hall which they described as the best Art Deco building in WA. I was informed that the second World Conference of Art Deco Societies in 1993 visited Beverley just to observe the Town Hall.

After their heritage walk, they presented me, as representative of the community, with a framed copy of artist Ron Facius's drawing of the Town Hall completed in 2006.

## Swimming Pool Development

The Swimming Pool Redevelopment Stage 1 works are progressing well. Demolition of the plant room including backwash tank, children's pools and the main pool's gutter drainage has been completed. Excavation of the ramp and stair access has been completed and the concrete wall in this area removed. Form work will begin to go up for the children's pools, Wetdeck drainage and ramp/stair access in the coming weeks. ## In Brief

- **Vincent Street crossings.** Markers have now been placed on both sides of all Wombat Crossings in Vincent Street clearly stating that at these Crossings pedestrians must give way to motor vehicles.
- **WA Vintage Speedster Car Club.** The Shire is now in discussion with this club and the Tractor Pull and Lawn Mowing Racing Association to come to a mutually beneficial arrangement for both groups to use the Old Racecourse.



# AVONDALE FARM OPENING WEEKEND



After many years of not being open to the public, Avondale Farm opened its gates for an introductory weekend on the 12th and 13th of April. A couple of special attractions were the donkeys from the Donkey Society of WA along with the band in the seed grading shed, and the horses Betty and Baby Boots near the stables.

The donkeys were a HUGE hit!! They were in constant demand with people asking about them all weekend. Their owners were kept busy fielding questions about where to get one and how to keep them. We may have to see about having them visit more often!

Betty the draught horse was going to be using the horseworks to operate the chaffcutter in the stables but due to a glitch with the machinery she got the day off. Her owner, Bec of Wheatbelt Draught Horses, was kept busy explaining to visitors how the machinery would normally have operated in the 1890s Stables and telling them about its history.



The band Crippled Blind and Crazy started playing around eleven in the morning on Saturday and again on Sunday in the Seed grading Shed and played throughout the day to those passing by to the Homestead. They played requests along with their own selection of Country, Rock and Blues numbers.



The Homestead was a hive of activity where you could help yourself to a tea or coffee for one dollar, look through the old building and check out the art stalls of Nutty Art World and her friend Deb. Some visitors even brought their own tucker and enjoyed a picnic. Beverley's own local volunteer, Isobel, was kept busy showing people the tree planted by the former Prince Charles in 1979. This area has been her project for the last year or so as she took it upon herself to clear and beautify the small stand of trees near the Homestead and it has now become a lovely area to sit and ponder.



It was heartwarming to see the playground come to life with kids on swings and jumping on the bridge on the Fort. The sounds of children laughing and playing echoing down to the Machinery Museum where they could also pat a Clydesdale horse and view turkeys, ducks and bantams.

At the Museum itself the Shire volunteers were showing off the display of farm machinery from over the ages. These men upkeep the old machines and inform visitors of the immense history behind them. I would like to thank these chaps for their time and enthusiasm to open up on the Saturday and to allow me to admit visitors on the Sunday.



Even without the added attractions of this weekend Avondale Farm is a place to visit with many things to keep you busy for an afternoon. From the many historic buildings where you can learn of the local history, to the scenic drive, bushwalk, Clydesdale horses to pat and many beautiful places to indulge in a picnic. There is a little bit of something for the whole family to enjoy.

I sincerely hope to see more of you coming to enjoy your own local attraction located on Beverley's doorstep as it is open every weekend until November and on weekdays by appointment.

## Vincent St & Hunt Rd Corner

← Diagram to the left is a representation of the buildings & businesses that once operated at the four corners of Vincent St and Hunt Rd (Great Southern Hwy).

This is the intersection of the first two main streets in Beverley. Before the railway came, Hunt Rd was the business street of Beverley. There was a Police & Telegraph Station on the corner of Elizabeth St, a hotel (now Dead Finish Museum), a general store, a blacksmith and a saleyard. After the railway came in the 1880s, businesses moved or began opening in Vincent St. The four corners at the intersection were prime locations, had the best of both streets and many successful enterprises were conducted there.



While the weather is still warm, it's a great chance to get the kids outside and create some art on the blackboard easel.



Arriving early June is national award-winning photographer **Dale Neill** and his wife Margaret.



**Farmer or Photographer**  
In primary school Dale dreamt of being a farmer in Benjaberring. When he realised that was a bridge too far, he did the next best thing. He married a farmer’s daughter from Perenjori.

Dale Neill is coming to Beverley in June 2025, and if you don’t know who Dale Neill is, then clearly you haven’t been paying attention—to photography, to art, or to what’s left of culture outside the capital cities.

He’s now 81 years old. He’s taken more photographs than most people have had hot meals. He’s cycled across more outback roads in WA than an entire Tour de France peloton could handle, and he’s done it without the fanfare—just a man, a camera, and a bit of a talent for telling stories.

Dale Neill is not your Instagram hobbyist. He is not here to show you how to “capture your best angle” or “shoot golden hour selfies.” He is the real thing: a Master photographer whose work has hung in the National Portrait Gallery, who

has documented everything from tsunami orphans in India to the cracked smiles of Wheatbelt farmers and their faithful dogs. He’s taught cops, journalists, pros, Mums and Dads. Past student, American Molly Immerzeel: *‘Dale makes the complex seem simple and the simple seem like fun’*
