Shire President Notes for May 2026 Blarney

Beverley Airshow 11 April 2026 – what an incredible day of activity in the air, displays on the ground and beautiful wheatbelt weather. With 8003 ticket holders and many hundreds more volunteers, stall holders, staff, pilots, media etc, there was a huge crowd at the Beverley airfield. Almost 3 years in the planning, the successful Shire lead event was achieved through partnership with the Beverley Soaring Society, engagement of the Paul Bennett Airshow team, many very willing community contributors, Councils' confidence to underwrite the event should it be needed, and a committed team of shire staff, not the least a dynamic duo in Stefan de Beer and Jacinta Murray. The resulting event was truly amazing, and comments flowing have been positive, highly complementary, and many visitors, vendors and sponsors are asking when the next show is scheduled. At the time of writing an event debrief is yet to be held, following which there may be more feedback for the community.

Office of Auditor General – financial auditing for local government is now overseen by the Office of Auditor General (OAG), and for a third year the Shire of Beverley has been recognised as one of Local Government's best practice entities for financial reporting and controls. Our best practice status has been included in the OAG's Local Government 2025 – Financial Audit Results tabled to Parliament in April. Congratulations to the Shire's Finance & Governance team lead by Deputy CEO Simon Marshall on this achievement.

Independent Presiding Member – State Government review of the Local Government Act requires all Local Governments to appoint an Independent Chair to their Audit, Risk and Improvement Committee by 30 June 2026. Council has endorsed the Officers Recommendation to appoint Katrina Crute as the Independent Presiding Member. Cr Sattler previously chaired the ARIC and remains on the Committee along with Councillors Maxwell and Ridgway.

Solid Yellow Line – it has become apparent some motorists may not be aware that a solid yellow line along the edge of a street indicates not to park there. A particularly relevant location in Beverley is on the eastern side of Queen St between the Vines and Hotel Beverley. The road is not overly wide and vehicles parking too close to the Vincent St entry make it difficult for some vehicles to egress onto the main street, particularly larger vehicles and those towing trailers or caravans. Vehicles parked in the yellow lined area also run the risk of being damaged, likely with no access to insurance due to doing so.

Swimming Pool – Thankyou to the community for your challenged patience over the summer months which saw the pool open for a very short 25/26 season. It was terrific to have it well used over Easter for the extended days agreed to by Council. Western Power are now completing the power upgrade. The Shire has “shovel ready” plans to build realigned modern facilities for Stage 2 when external co-funding can be achieved.

Easter in Beverley – Congratulations to the Beverley Station Arts on another successful Beverley Art Prize exhibition and the Beverley Lawn Tennis Club on another bumper event with maximum registrations. The staging of both events requires much preparation in the lead up and a huge effort during and after on the part of their members and supporters, adding to successful Easter weekends in Beverley which attracts many former residents and visitors.

Membership guide and conditions handbook



This handbook explains who can become a member, your rights and responsibilities, and how membership works.

By becoming a member, you agree to support the Society's objects and comply with its Constitution and rules.

Membership is open to:

- Individuals aged 16 years and over who are of good character
- Firms, companies, or organisations of good reputation

To join, you must:

- Support the objects of the Society
- Complete the membership application process
- Pay the required membership fee

Types of Membership

Ordinary Member (Standard or Gold Membership)

Approved individuals, businesses, or organisations.

If a business or organisation joins, it must nominate one person to represent it. That nominated person may attend and vote at General Meetings (if 18 years or older) and stand for Committee positions.

Junior Member

For individuals aged 16 to 17 years.

- May receive selected Standard Membership benefits
- Do not have voting rights

Honorary Life Member

Awarded by Special Resolution to individuals or organisations who have given outstanding service to the Society.

Honorary Life Members:

- Do not pay membership fees
- Enjoy privileges determined by the Committee (equivalent to Gold Membership where applicable)

Membership Fees

Membership fees are set by Members at the Annual General Meeting (AGM).

Fees are due annually by 31 July, unless otherwise advised by the Committee.

Membership applications must be submitted and paid in full prior to 31 July. Applications received after this date will not be accepted for that membership year unless otherwise determined by the Committee.

How to Become a Member

To apply:

- Complete and submit the official membership application form online, or complete a hard copy form available on the website, at the Post Office, or at the Blarney.
- Pay the required membership fee.

The Committee reviews all applications and may accept or decline them.

If your application is declined, you may appeal the decision within 14 days of notification.

Committee Discretion

The Committee may:

- Extend membership periods
- Reduce membership fees
- Approve alternative payment dates

These decisions are made at the Committee's discretion.

Members' Register

The Society maintains a Register of Members.

Members may:

- Request to inspect the Register
- Request a copy (a reasonable fee may apply)

Register information must not be used for advertising, political, religious, charitable, or commercial purposes without Committee approval.

Suspension or Expulsion

A Member may be suspended or expelled if they:

- Breach the Constitution
- Act in a way that is detrimental to the Society

The Member will:

- Receive written notice (at least 28 days prior)
- Be informed of the reasons
- Be given an opportunity to respond
- Receive written confirmation of the decision

Suspended Members cannot vote or exercise membership rights during suspension.

Members may appeal a suspension or expulsion within 14 days of receiving notice.

Member Liability

Members:

- Must pay their membership fees
- Are not personally liable for the debts of the Society solely because they are a Member

Beverley River Care Group

As the season begins to shift from the long, hot summer, and after a few false starts that have raised hopes for steady rainfall across the district, the Beverley River Care Group is preparing for a focused program of on-ground works and community activities over the cooler months.

Our focus remains straightforward.

Through this work, we aim to raise awareness of the river within our community, make practical improvements to the river and its surrounding environment, and support other efforts that share these goals. There is nothing flashy in what we do. We are guided by the solid research and planning developed over many years, with valuable input from long term residents.

While watering the trees planted along the walk trail and town firebreak, from John Street south towards the Pony Club and tennis courts, we noticed extensive growth of invasive perennial veldt grass. This grass forms dense, continuous cover and, as it dries off, creates a significant fine fuel load. With the steady work of our weeding team, some areas have already been pushed back. On your walks along here you may start to see native plants and grasses returning. These tend to be lower growing, suppress weeds and less continuous, which can help reduce fire spread, and once the veldt grass is removed, this project will also open up clearer views towards the river.

We will keep this work manageable. Small, steady steps are the key.

This project will create a demonstration area showing how targeted weed control can reduce fuel loads and improve both fire management and the appeal of the trail. We may also introduce plantings such as creeping saltbush (*Atriplex semibaccata*), a low growing species with low flammability that provides food for bobtails and skinks with its red berries.

We will need community support to do this work well. In the next edition of the Blarney, we will publish a series of fortnightly dates for upcoming busy bees.

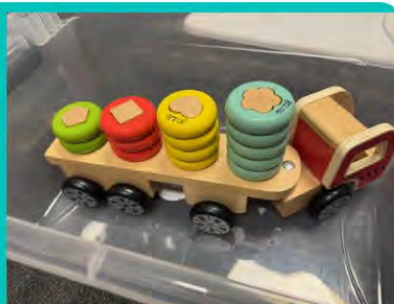

DALE RIVER RESERVE FERAL ANIMAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

A successful Integrated Feral Animal Management Workshop held at the Dale River Reserve on the 26th of March initiated the Feral Animal Management Program being undertaken by Friends of the Dale River. Participants were shown practical options for managing various feral pests with an emphasis on controlling foxes and feral cats. Demonstrations of trapping, poison options as well as monitoring were covered and general discussions were held with participants on the observed presence and threats of feral animals in the district.

A cage trapping program for feral animals, specifically foxes and feral cats, will now be undertaken in the Dale River Reserve and participating private properties in proximity to the reserve.

The trapping will be undertaken by Licensed Pest Manager Technician, Aaron Baxter of Wheatbelt Vermin Control in a series of six 2-week sessions scheduled to start late April early May and then again in June/July, August/September & October/November 2026 and in March/April and May/June 2027. **Signage indicating the presence of traps will be located at the entrance to the Reserve during the trapping sessions.**

Cage traps will be set with non-toxic baits and checked on a daily basis, any trapped feral animals will be immediately euthanised on site.

If any domestic animals are trapped every effort will be taken to locate their owners, if this is unsuccessful the animal will be transferred to the Beverley Shire Ranger. Please ensure that your pets do not roam away from your property for their own wellbeing and help protect and preserve our wildlife.

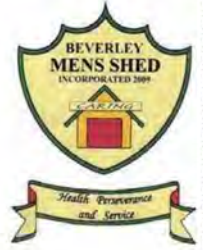

BEVERLEY HISTORICAL SOCIETY presents

Selby Avon Ford

1900-1963



On display at the recent Beverley Airshow was Beverley's own bi-plane, the Silver Centenary designed by local entrepreneur Selby Avon Ford. Selby had a flair for, and inventive ability in, mechanical and electronic spheres that

brought him a measure of fame which spread far beyond the confines of his own district

Selby Avon Ford was born in Perth, the son of the Mr and Mrs Ernst Ford, who soon came to farm a property at East Beverley. Selby was educated at the Beverley State School. It was during his school days that his proclivity in the mechanical field first asserted itself. Everything mechanical appeared to fascinate him and whilst still at school he built his first model - a tiny steam engine which worked and was a source of wonder to other school fellows. These were the days which shaped all his future. Marconi's discoveries in the field of wireless transmission were causing tremendous interest throughout the scientific world and Selby was caught up in it all. He was soon experimenting with a home-built crystal receiving set with which he had some success. This was undoubtedly the first set in this district.



It was not long after his schooldays ended that Selby first became associated with the Beverley Power House where his mechanical bent had further rein. His parents retired to Beverley where Mr Ford senior was to purchase the business. Selby was soon in charge, his father attending to the bookkeeping side of the enterprise. On the death of Mr. Ford senior, the business came entirely into his ownership.

He had married as a young man, the partner of his choice being Miss Rita Sewell a nurse at the local hospital. Selby & Rita had two daughters and two sons. The business eventually became known as the Beverley Electricity Supply. The firm kept pace with the growing electrical needs of Beverley and frequent additions kept the plant very up to date. The service was regarded as one of the most reliable to be found anywhere in the State. It was a rare occurrence indeed for Beverley consumers to be without power. Other business interests grew with the growth of the electronics industry, the firm supplying and servicing all types of electrical goods. The coming of television to W.A. was a landmark in their progress and they were among the first to install sets here.



The Silver Centenary

It was inevitable with the boom in aviation following the first world war that Selby's inventive mind should turn to this latest of man's conquests. Determined to build his own plane, in 1928 Selby drew plans in chalk on the floor of the Beverley Electric

Power House located in Dawson St. Over the next two years in company with his cousin, Tom Shackles, a biplane was constructed, which was to become famous in this State - the Silver Centenary - named in honour of the State's Centenary in 1929. The Silver Centenary took to the air in Benson's Field (opposite the Dead Finish Museum) performing excellently and ultimately being flown to Perth by Captain Nesbitt.

Although the plane flew regularly & safely for a couple of years it was unable to be certified and it retired to hang in the roof of the Power House in 1933. In 1964 the plane became the centrepiece of Beverley's new Aeronautical Museum. From 2005 Selby's grandson Rod Edwards restored the plane to airworthiness.
