# SHIRE OF BEVERLEY PRESIDENT'S NOTES



Shire President Notes for June 2026 Blarney

Monthly Council Meetings – the Shire of Beverley holds 11 Ordinary Council meetings, commencing 3pm on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month (except December to accommodate the Christmas break). A date may be varied to accommodate a public holiday, this is included in pre-set meeting dates on the Shire website, currently no meeting is held in January. Dates for the remainder of 2026 are as follows: 24 June, 22 July, 26 August, 23 September, 28 October, 25 November and 16 December.

The Monthly Ordinary Council meeting is open to the public as observers or to ask a question of Council. Public Question Time is held near the beginning of the meeting and enables a maximum of three questions to be asked if these cannot be readily answered during the meeting they will be taken on notice and responded to either by letter or at the next meeting. Following public question time visitors are most welcome to remain as observers only.

If attending, please be present at 2.50pm to fill out an attendance form and be aware that Ordinary Council Meetings are now audio recorded which is placed on the Shire Website under Minutes.

Council meetings are now held in the Civic Centre (Old School Building next to the Shire office) and entry is the door via the pathway between the fountain and post office fence.

rPPP – regional Precincts and Partnerships Program – grant application unsuccessful. The shire has been advised after applying in September 2024 (around 600 days ago) that the application for rPPP funding which would have provided comprehensive planning for the Beverley 2035 project was not successful.

**Beverley 2035 is a comprehensive guiding overview for Beverley's future growth and was developed with the community and external assistance, requiring a large amount of financial and time resource, including submission of the grant application.**

Whilst the outcome of the grant application is immensely disappointing, Council will consider how it now might progress various components of Beverley 2035 in future budgets once feedback has been received on the application. The funding is under the Department of Industry, Science and Resources, promoted as *supporting economic growth and job creation for all Australians*.

Year 4/5 Class Letters – the Shire received a delightful letter of thanks from the Beverley District High School Year 4/5 class and their teacher Jaylee Tonkin. The class expressed their appreciation to the Shire for the many services and facilities provided and work done to make Beverley a fun, welcoming and enjoyable place for children and families, which included sporting facilities, swimming pool, Ag Show, river park, airshow, skate park, roads and a clean town.

ANZAC Day – as the local RSL currently struggle as an organisation, the Shire have arranged town ANZAC Day services for the last two years. Thanks to Ali Lewis for those arrangements and the community members involved with the various services, also to the school cadets.

The Shire is interested to hear from any new community members with a background in the armed forces who may wish to be involved in rejuvenation of the local RSL and future ANZAC day services.

Shire Budget – the 26/27 Shire budgetary process is in progress. The current economic climate and cost pressures faced by the community are faced by the Shire also, Council and staff are mindful of the challenges.

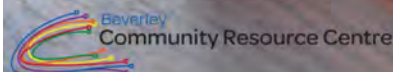

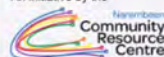

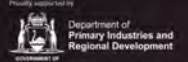

# Membership guide and conditions handbook



This handbook explains who can become a member, your rights and responsibilities, and how membership works.

By becoming a member, you agree to support the Society's objects and comply with its Constitution and rules.

## Membership is open to:

- Individuals aged 16 years and over who are of good character
- Firms, companies, or organisations of good reputation

## To join, you must:

- Support the objects of the Society
- Complete the membership application process
- Pay the required membership fee

## Types of Membership

Ordinary Member (Standard or Gold Membership)

Approved individuals, businesses, or organisations.

If a business or organisation joins, it must nominate one person to represent it. That nominated person may attend and vote at General Meetings (if 18 years or older) and stand for Committee positions.

## Junior Member

For individuals aged 16 to 17 years.

- May receive selected Standard Membership benefits
- Do not have voting rights

## Honorary Life Member

Awarded by Special Resolution to individuals or organisations who have given outstanding service to the Society.

Honorary Life Members:

- Do not pay membership fees
- Enjoy privileges determined by the Committee (equivalent to Gold Membership where applicable)

## Membership Fees

Membership fees are set by Members at the Annual General Meeting (AGM).

Fees are due annually by 31 July, unless otherwise advised by the Committee.

Membership applications must be submitted and paid in full prior to 31 July. Applications received after this date will not be accepted for that membership year unless otherwise determined by the Committee.

## How to Become a Member

To apply:

- Complete and submit the official membership application form online, or complete a hard copy form available on the website, at the Post Office, or at the Blarney.
- Pay the required membership fee.

The Committee reviews all applications and may accept or decline them.

If your application is declined, you may appeal the decision within 14 days of notification.

# Membership guide and conditions handbook



## Committee Discretion

The Committee may:

- Extend membership periods
- Reduce membership fees
- Approve alternative payment dates

These decisions are made at the Committee's discretion.

## Members' Register

The Society maintains a Register of Members.

Members may:

- Request to inspect the Register
- Request a copy (a reasonable fee may apply)

Register information must not be used for advertising, political, religious, charitable, or commercial purposes without Committee approval.

## Suspension or Expulsion

A Member may be suspended or expelled if they:

- Breach the Constitution
- Act in a way that is detrimental to the Society

The Member will:

- Receive written notice (at least 28 days prior)
- Be informed of the reasons
- Be given an opportunity to respond
- Receive written confirmation of the decision

Suspended Members cannot vote or exercise membership rights during suspension.

Members may appeal a suspension or expulsion within 14 days of receiving notice.

## Member Liability

Members:

- Must pay their membership fees
- Are not personally liable for the debts of the Society solely because they are a Member

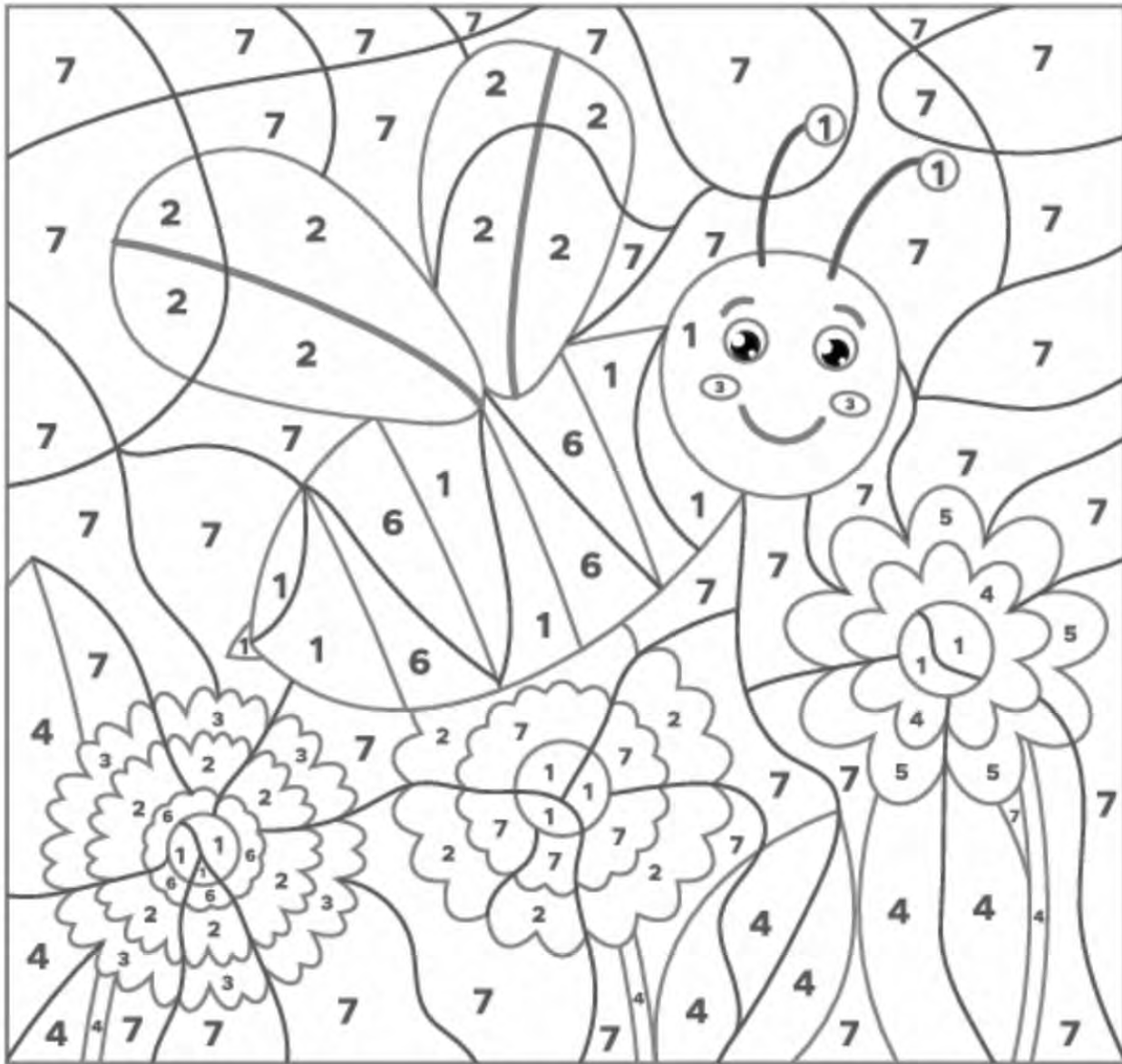

Before planting began, local farmers would guide their tractors, ploughs, seeders, and utes along the road to the church grounds. There, beneath the old stone walls, the community gathered for the blessing of the plough.

With the planting of 2026 crops commencing we begin our Blessing of the Plough ceremonies. While ploughs are rarely used in modern farming it is good to acknowledge our dependence upon God in all things and ask his blessing upon our 2026 season.

## Communication Differences

BY THE REGIONAL MEN'S HEALTH INITIATIVE

As blokes we often get told *men just don't talk!* However, in the work we do we have come to realise that when given the right circumstances and a safe environment, blokes do talk. Sometimes this involves us disclosing personal issues or just telling our story.

In our modern society we seem to have increased life pressures to the point where we reach breaking point in our relationships. Relationships are more than just our partners and can include our workplace interactions, dealing with children or even our parents. We need to encourage understanding of the *need to listen and be heard* in all relationships. Sometimes we are guilty of misunderstanding someone of the opposite sex. We need to maintain the basics when communicating; talking, listening, taking time to hear and be heard and not just acknowledging and contributing a few fleeting words on the run.



Modern technology, even though it is part of the mix, can never replace the basic need for face-to-face communication. Most of our communication is non-verbal, so when we don't have access to a person's body language, messages are often misunderstood.

To achieve more effective communication, firstly we must acknowledge the differences between the genders (men are hardwired differently, are risk takers, winners and problem solvers), and secondly,

differ on how we go about communicating. There is no right or wrong, but we need to recognise the differences such as:

- Blokes generally talk less than ladies.
- Ladies speak in a narrative way.
- Single word answers (yes/no/good/ok) are often valid responses for blokes.
- Blokes find it harder to talk about their emotions, we are hardwired differently but over time have also been conditioned not to talk.

Men, in particular, are challenged by their lack of verbal skills, so we need to recognise when we are worried, be encouraged to seek help and importantly be asked what the problem is. We need to question, *has he resolved the problem and how has he resolved the problem?*

One of the most difficult things for men and women is the ability to discuss issues with the significant people in their lives. These issues can be about relationships, children, farm ownership, health and a range of other matters which affect our inner wellbeing. Often the *unspoken issues* create long term destructive relationship issues that are difficult to resolve.

We need to develop positive communication skills. Some useful tips aimed at assisting with a more productive outcome when communicating, include:

- Choosing the right environment.
- Timing is an important factor to consider - make time.
- When discussing an issue be open to alternate solutions and a realistic compromise.
- Be prepared to listen, listen, listen!
- Identify the relevant mates you can *trust* to discuss matters of concern.
- Getting help if all else is failing.

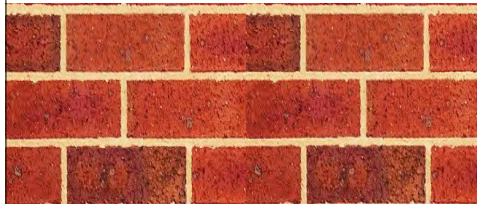

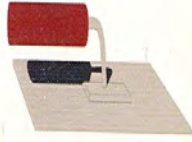

## Local Ruins Field Trip

On Monday 11 May members of the Beverley Historical Society spent a sunny morning inspecting some ruins on private properties in the vicinity of Beverley.



In the same area was a group of plovers preparing for nesting on rising paddocks that had not been cropped for several years. Plovers were once plentiful in the wheatbelt but are a rare sight these days.



A remarkably intact well-built stone chimney on Billbarin Hill to the east of the town, indicates the site of a family cottage, probably built in the late 1900s.



A little further east is a deep well, with beautifully constructed stone-lined walls. Well sinking of this quality was the work of experienced well contractors such as W Cowan (1920), Wilson & Jordan (1920s), Edwards & House (1930s), E.B. Hammersley (1938), Hearn & Radish (1953).



Just off the road to Morbinning are the remains of a cottage built by William Ellis, a very early settler from the 1830s. He began with a small holding of 100 acres which he later named Springfield.

At the top of Simmons Road is the remainder of an underground cold store with a narrow entryway built into the side of the hill. It formerly had a gabled tin roof. It was used to store meat from an abattoir located nearby.



At Mt Amy is an unusual hemispherical concrete dome cover of a water tank or cistern. These covers were built from the 1930s to the 1970s across the wheatbelt.

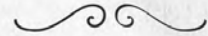
